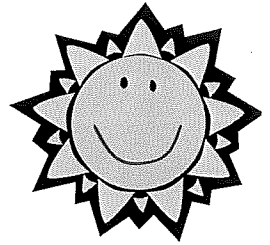




# St. Agnes School Newsletter
